

### OVERVIEW:

Our Health Care Team as scheduled, visited a tribal territory: CHENGADI, located 75 Km from Hanur, in the deep forests. This tribal area is situated right on the top of a mountain which made our 6 hours journey exhausting. But nothing to compare with the difficult daily life these people have to bare.



Rare cultivations are seen in these arid mountains without proper water facilities all over you can find only hilly and forest areas. Villagers find it so difficult to overcome their minimum expenses.

They walk to Hanur or by bullock-cart once a month to buy their basic food and needs as their location lacks basic transport facility.



### HEALTH:

We catered basic medications at no cost to 19 patients (2 male, 15 female 2 children) suffering from joint pains (Arthritis), skin infections, dental anomalies, worm infestations, gynaecological problems and malnutrition. They indeed were very happy to get the medical care.

### FOLLOW-UP:

We referred some patients with serious infections immediately to JJT Paediatrician at Hanur Clinic for further treatment and we keep in touch in a very serious method through our Social worker to assess their problems and needs which we will report and discuss with the competent Govt offices.

JJT is going to schedule social/health awareness programs all over the Hanur District where the Ambulance has already done the survey.
